The Spring 2010 Stevne at Camp Norge is an opportunity to review favorite regional Norwegian dances previously taught and to share favorites amongst our dance groups. Our focus this year will include the dances of Ålesund and Sunnmøre, as well as those of Nordland/Finnmark, where Swedish, Finnish, and Russian musical influences combined. In addition, we will introduce strategies for choosing dances to do at a party according to the variety of music played (2/4 and 3/4 rhythms, gammeldans styles).

The even-beat springars of western Norway are challenging but accessible to all levels of dancers. In honor of the Ålesund Spelmanslag, who plan to visit California this summer, we will teach (or review) the Springdansen from Nordre Sunnmøre, as taught by Svein Are Vatnehol at the 2006 Spring Stevne. Other dances for the teaching sessions will include Veva Vadmal, the pols-based Gilleråsen, Kerenski, and assorted reinlendars. Reviews of the Vågå springleik and Røros regional dances will also be available.

The weekend parties will offer plenty of opportunities for including all levels of dancers in mixers and other easy dances. Does your dance group have favorite mixers? Please plan to share them with us during the weekend. In the past, we have posted all dance requests and included as many as possible in our parties. Send us your request in advance, if you like.

Dance instructors are **Meg Laycock** and **Tom Sears**, artistic directors of Nordahl Grieg Leikarring. Dance instruction will be with recorded music.

We have a brand-new arrangement for this weekend's food—dedicated cooking professionals will prepare and serve all our meals! Yes, we know that an important part of the Stevne ambiance has always been those hours of camaraderie in the Camp Norge kitchen. Never fear—we'll still need creative volunteers to set up and decorate for Saturday's dinner.

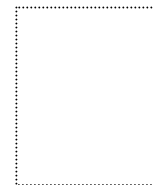
