Nordahl Grieg Leikarring og Spelemannslag, in cooperation with Noregs Ungdomslag, presents a NEW week-long teacher training course in English for North America! Following the teaching workshop will be a weekend workshop like those we have offered for the past 15 years. All levels of dance and music experience are welcome. Attendance at the training workshop is limited to 20. Weekend attendance (as usual) is limited only by the available lodging space.

We are delighted to welcome back **Signe Marie Hernes** and **Rune Bjerke**, who taught Lanciers, Karenski, Bru Nr. Fire, Korsdans frå Grue, etc. on their last visit. They are skilled, high-energy teachers and performers with delightful personalities.

About the Teacher Training In Norway, Noregs Ungdomslag (Norwegian Youth Organization) offers an intensive course to train and certify Norwegian teachers of folk dance and music. The curriculum includes theoretical and practical information about the history of Norwegian dance traditions, teaching, conducting dance research, organizing classes, and more. NGLS will offer similar certification through Noregs Ungdomslag. Two weeks of training (one this year and one next) will provide the 80 hours needed, followed by the option of certification. Certified or not, we'll have the pleasure of acquiring new skills and knowledge to take back to our group or community and spread our love of this rich tradition.

Noregs Ungdomslag will set the standards and provide a qualified couple to teach each course. This year our instructors will be **Signe Marie** and **Rune**. Next year we will have **Johan Einar Bjerkem** and **Torunn Hernes**, who have taught this course in Norway for the last couple of years.

The introduction and orientation will be Sunday evening after dinner. Monday through Friday we will have morning and afternoon classes and practice teaching, with dance and music in the evenings.

If you register early enough, we will mail advance copies of some of the dance descriptions and words and music for the songdances, so you can become familiar with them before the course.

Music **Torill Aasegg**, our music teacher from Norway, is very skilled in all the Norwegian folk music, including bygdedans, gammeldans, and turdans from all parts of the country. Torill won Landskappleiken in 2001 and is a wonderful teacher who has worked with musicians in Norway. In addition to the regular music classes, she may also offer instruction in how to teach Norwegian folk music.

Toby Weinberg leads the hardingfelelag in the Boston area, as well as performing and teaching throughout the United States. In 2001 he placed second at the Porsgrund Kappleik. Toby will offer instruction on hardingfele and seljefløyte.

Bill Likens will teach accordion during the weekend and will lead ensemble for the evening dance parties on Friday and Saturday evenings. Musicians attending are invited to play together for these parties. **Ginny Lee** will be the head chef.

Camp Norge is located near Alta, California. Alta is halfway between Auburn and Truckee on Interstate 80. The camp is approximately 1/4 mile from I-80. From eastbound I-80, take the Alta exit, turn right at the stop sign, and follow the signs. Camp Norge Phone: (530) 389-2508. 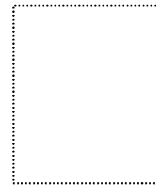
