Nordahl Grieg Leikarring og Spelemannslag presents a weekend of Norwegian folk dance and music featuring the Norwegian dance teachers Torunn Hernes and Johan-Einar Bjerkem; the Norwegian musician Steinar Johansen, teaching torader (two-row button accordion) and fele (fiddle); and from NY, Toby Weinberg teaching hardingfele (Hardanger fiddle) and seljefløyte (willow flute).

Back by popular demand, on their fourth Stevne with us, Johan-Einar and Torunn will teach kontradans and other set dances from Norway. They learned the traditional dances as children from their parents, and are passing on that tradition to their own children. They have taught, lectured and performed, with great joy and humor, throughout Norway and abroad to all ages and abilities.

Steinar is from Norway and now lives in southern California. He has played, performed and taught the torader in Norway and other European countries and the USA and has composed many great tunes. As both a dancer and musician, he fiddles with a drive that pulls you onto the dance floor.

Toby, from Syracuse, NY, is nationally recognized as a performer and teacher of traditional Norwegian music both on Hardanger fiddle and ordinary violin. He is the founder and music director of the Boston Spelemannslag, has performed widely throughout North America, and has received respectable scores in competition on the national level in Norway.

Dance music will be provided by Steinar, Vestafor (a dance and music trio consisting of Ginny Lee, Toby Weinberg and Mikkel Thompson), and other musicians from the Nordahl Grieg Spelemannslag and the weekend workshops.

Ginny Lee and Toby Weinberg will again organize and prepare our delicious meals.

Everyone is welcome to attend. For the Camp Norge experience, we hope to provide both challenges for the most experienced dancers and a supportive environment for the newest beginners.

Camp Norge is located near Alta, California. Alta is halfway between Auburn and Truckee on Interstate 80. The camp is approximately 1/4 mile from I-80. 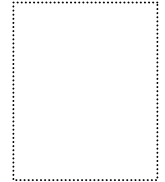
