Itinerary:

Monday, June 20, 2005: Arrive in Røros, by mid-afternoon. This evening we will dance with Margot's Leikarring, The Røros Danslaget (laget = team), at their regular meeting.

Tuesday, June 21st. We will practice for our performance the next day. We will also have some time to tour Røros.

Wednesday, June 22nd. **Landskappleiken Røros 2005 Day 1.** There is a Public Dance in the evening as the first event in the Landskappleiken. Those of us who have/will volunteer to help could work on registration earlier in the day.

Thursday, June 23rd. **Landskappleiken Røros 2005 Day 2.** Team dance competitions in the afternoon from 1:00PM to 6:00PM. THIS IS OUR PERFORMANCE/COMPETITION. Tom has asked that we be scheduled to dance early in the afternoon so we can then watch all the other dancers. Every day, there are many activities during the day, starting at 10AM and continuing until 6-7PM. There are concerts every evening starting at 7:30 to 9:00PM.

Sunday, June 26th. **Landskappleiken Røros 2005 Day 5.** This is the day of the final concert of the winners of all the competitions (Meister Concerten). From 12 Noon to 3:00PM.

Monday, June 27th. Today we will tour Røros. There are many artisans and craftsmen in Røros. Very interesting to tour.

Tuesday, June 28th. Today we will take the bus to Ålesund. We will need to leave early in order to allow time for sightseeing along the way. In Ålesund we will be met by Leikarring members who will host us in their homes.

Wednesday, June 29th. In Ålesund, we will be hosted by two Leikarringen, and will perform our American Suite for them, dance with them, and be taught by them.

The town of Ålesund had a major fire on January 23, 1904, and was rebuilt in the then current Art Nouveau style. There was a great deal of help provided by Kaiser Wilhelm of Germany. The Art Nouveau style is known as “Jugendstil,” see the web site: www.jugendstil.no for more information.
